Statement will be provided to the Management Contractor by any and all involved within 24 hours upon the convoys return.

7. Page 12, Paragraph g(5) and (7) are deleted in their entirety.

8. Page 23, Section 30, **ORDERING**, paragraph (d) is deleted in its entirety.

**C. The following changes are made to the Offeror Submission Package:**

1. Page O-4, **BASIC PERIOD: April 1, 2004 through June 30, 2004** is deleted and replaced by the amended version of the OFFEROR SCHEDULE located on Page 2 the subject amendment. Quantities for all other option period are stated in paragraph 3 of this amendment.
2. Page O-9, the following correction is made:
