



B. Line Item 001-261 is decreased by 8800 USG from 139,000 USG to 130,200 USG.

C. Clause B1.01, SUPPLIES TO BE FURNISHED (DOMESTIC PC&S) (DESC MAR 1999), is hereby modified to add the following delivery narrative note under Line Item 001-261.

Delivery Terms:

Contractor will supply requirement, loading into intermodal container at Government's facility. Contractor will be required to obtain and adequately blend base stocks (87 Octane unleaded gasoline, 93 Octane unleaded gasoline, and additives) to assure a homogeneous blend of the finished product (89 Octane unleaded gasoline) in the container. An independent testing lab located at the contractor's facility should expedite the required testing of the finished product. Contractor will provide a full-specification test report on the batch-blended product from the container after loading has been completed. Contractor will annotate on the loading DD 250, Material Inspection and Receiving Report, the total quantity of gasoline loaded, type and quantity of additives blended, and attach a copy of the full specification test report of the batch testing which will show characteristics tested, test method, specification requirement, and test result. Contractor will accept liability for the quality as outlined in Clause E1.10, Contractor Inspection Responsibilities. In lieu of Clause C16.18-17 (c), Contractor will supply conventional gasoline in accordance with the state of Florida regulatory requirements at the time of loading into the intermodal container(s). All other specification requirements must be in compliance with ASTM D4814.
