1. Provision will be made to accommodate DESC representatives in the contractor M&O offices as required by the PWS to include a private office workspace, computer, FAX, and telephone. However, will the contractor be responsible for the software, maintenance and operating costs as well?

R The requirement for office space to include computer, FAX and telephone for DESC representatives in the PWS is hereby deleted.

2. What type of Quality Control (QC) inspections and tests conducted by the contractor do you require? (No definitive contractual requirement). Or, is QC to be totally up to us and outlined in our proposed management plan?

R. None. The only requirement for Quality Control is that the contractor pulls and forwards samples to a laboratory designated by DESC Europe.

3. It is our impression that the contract loading sites operated by the TURKISH MINISTRY OF DEFENSE POL DIVISION (“MOD-ANT”). As the M&O contractor, we will oversee DESC transportation contractors and MOD-ANT to ensure that they are performing their duties without difficulty or discrepancies. Will this requirement extend to laboratory testing, and if so, where? Also, what “authority” will we have over these entities as an M&O contractor?

R: Contractor’s requirement is to oversee operations and report deficiencies to DESC Europe. There is no requirement for contractor to oversee laboratory testing. We have a contract with Caleb Brett performing this function in Turkey and will be using DESC Europe’s laboratory in Kaiserslautern, Germany.

4. Do you have a DESC representative in Iraq that the contractor can contact in the event of discrepancies with conveyances during en-route and at destinations? Can you clearly specify the reporting and request for assistance channels?

R. Point of contact is DESC Incirlik.

5. Are the trucks fitted with GPS or other tracking devices?

R. No.

6. What is the number of discharge locations?

R. Four, as outlined in the PWS.

7. What is the location where interpreters are expected to be based?

R. At a minimum, interpreters must facilitate the downloading process and possibly one at customs.

8. Are all security, transportation, and non-payroll insurance costs directly related to the performance of this contract covered in CLIN 0002.

R. These cost should be included as part of your loaded labor rates.
