The purpose of this Amendment is to incorporate applicable changes to the Air Force Right of Way document to Solicitation SP0600-00-R-0048:

1. The following changes to the Air Force Right of Way, addressed below, are hereby incorporated to the Air Force Right of Way Document:

In Condition 22, *Other Grants of Access*, paragraph 22.2, the reference to Exhibit B.2 should be to Exhibit B.3. In Condition 28, *Liability*, paragraph 28.2 should have the words "the Government" where they first appear changed to "Grantor". The term Grantor is used consistently elsewhere in the ROW and should be used here as well. Where the words "the Government" next appear, at the end of the paragraph, the words should be replaced with the following: "...Grantor or, in regard to indemnification, to the extent Grantee is prohibited from doing so by Federal or state law."

Also note, it has been rightly noted that, not unlike the Anti-Deficiency Act for Federal entities, some states prohibit their public entities from incurring obligations beyond their authorized funding or capitalization. Since we cannot reasonably demand that a state agency engage in actions that are both ultra vires and beyond their ability to change, it is appropriate to condition the requirement to indemnify the United States to that effect. Reference to local law is not included because such local law would be enacted by the same entity that either controls or owns the utility system and therefore is within its ability to change.
