**(3) Responses to the questions proposed by prospective Offeror's:**

1. **Q.** What entity will be responsible to pay the utility costs for the WWTP and lift station facilities?. Power costs are some of the larger expenditures in a wastewater system. When can we anticipate this decision being made?  
**A. The Government will furnish all utilities.**
2. **Q.** There is a project under design presently to use sulfur dioxide to dechlorinate. Will the military proceed with the construction of this improvement or will the dechlorination infrastructure become the responsibility of the new owner? Please provide the monthly discharge ammonia parameters.  
**A. The Government will execute the project to allow for dechlorination. The ammonia parameter is 14 mg/l.**
3. **Q.** Since the liquid sludge application fields are not included in the easement for the WWTP usage, the new owner will need to haul the sludge in the sludge truck to agricultural land off the post site on a regular basis. What restrictions, if any, will apply to the truck or the driver coming in and out of the post gate several times per day?  
**A. The installation sludge fields that are listed in the "Installation Sludge Management Plan" is part of the WWTP. NPDES permit is available for use by the successful Offeror in accordance with that plan.**
