This amendment is issued to incorporate the following changes:

The switchgear located in Building 95 has been severely damaged in a fire; its viability and economical repair is not feasible. The switchgear in question is identified in Section J, Attachment J01, Walter Reed Army Medical Center: Main Campus Electrical Distribution System, under paragraph J01.2.1.1, and in Table 1 (Fixed Inventory). The Government is seeking to replace the switchgear and its appurtenances. In addition to the damage to the switchgear, the underground feeders between the switchgear and transformers have been damaged and require immediate replacement.

Immediately upon contract award, the offeror shall construct three (3) electrical switching stations, complete with housings, to replace the existing electrical switching network in Building 95. The Offeror shall construct two (2) of the switching stations adjacent to the existing facility (Building 95), and a third switching stations shall be constructed adjacent to the Hospital (Building 1). A typical switching station shall consist of breakers, comprehensive metering schemes, and shall have provisions for a future Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system. The Offeror shall provide the switching station with one normal and one backup incoming feeder, and five outgoing feeders. (The existing facility consists of three normal and one backup incoming feeders and fifteen outgoing feeders). While construction of the new switching stations is ongoing, the Offeror shall provide the Walter Reed Army Medical Center Main Campus with reliable, uninterrupted power, utilizing generators, or other means. In addition to the switchgear, the Offeror shall replace all underground feeders between the switchgear and transformers, consisting of approximately 27, 430 lineal feet of 1/0 and 500MCM cable; the existing underground duct banks may be reutilized and extended as necessary. Demolition of the existing switching station, including Building 95, shall be accomplished in conjunction with the replacement of the switching station. All demolished and removed materials will become the property of the successful offeror and shall be removed from the Walter Reed Army Medical Center by the Offeror.

All other terms and conditions of this solicitation will remain unchanged and in full effect.
