Re: Notice of Debarment

Ladies and Gentlemen:

By letter dated June 14, 2002, the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) suspended Lantern Software Solutions from Government procurement programs. On February 21, 2003, Lantern Software Solutions was notified that DLA was proposing to debar the company from procurement, nonprocurement and sales programs. That letter provided an opportunity to submit information and argument in opposition to the proposed debarment. An attorney for the company responded by letter dated September 6, 2002.

I have considered the information and argument submitted in opposition to the proposed debarment and the specific reasons for debarment are set forth in the enclosed memorandum. The debarment is effective immediately and continues for three years from June 14, 2002, the date the company was originally suspended from Government contracting. The company's debarment will terminate on June 13, 2005.

The February 21, 2003, Notice of Proposed Debarment states the effects of the debarment.
