Re: Notice of Debarment

Dear Mr. Heisler:

By letter dated June 14, 2002, the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) suspended you from Government procurement programs. On February 21, 2003, you were notified that DLA was proposing to debar you from procurement, nonprocurement and sales programs. That letter provided you with an opportunity to submit information and argument in opposition to the proposed debarment. Your attorney responded by letter dated September 6, 2002.

I have considered the information and argument you submitted in opposition to the proposed debarment and the specific reasons for your debarment are set forth in the enclosed memorandum. The debarment is effective immediately and continues for three years from June 14, 2002, the date you were originally suspended from Government contracting. Your debarment will terminate on June 13, 2005.

The February 21, 2003, Notice of Proposed Debarment states the effects of the debarment.
