1. This publication provides the official standard prices for Missile Fuel products managed under the Defense Working Capital Fund (DWCF) for fiscal year 2004 and fiscal year 2005. The standard prices published in this letter are intended to remain in effect throughout the fiscal year.
2. The standard price of the product includes all charges you will be assessed unless you have requested a special service, such as airlift and special container. Should a special service be requested, we would identify the cost to you and if you concur, we will bill you accordingly. We have included a CD of our Missile Fuels Reference Guide that provides a listing of the points of contact phone numbers, product lead times and a list of services we can provide.
3. Since we are getting close to the end of the fiscal year, we would like to take this opportunity to remind all of our customers to review their funding requirements. Customers with funding requirements that expire on 30 Sep 03 will need to submit a memorandum to DESC-RRF, referencing the expired "Customer Identification Codes" (CICs) and a statement that "funds will be provided as soon as available". A funding document for the next year may also be submitted as a "planning document". The "planning document" must be certified as soon as the funds are available. Notification of continuing requirements at Kennedy Space Center and Cape Canaveral is especially important. These documents will ensure uninterrupted deliveries to our customers.
