Re: Notice of Debarment

Dear Mr. Tricase:

By letter dated June 30, 2000, you were notified that the Defense Logistics Agency was proposing to debar you from Government procurement, nonprocurement and sales programs. That letter provided you with an opportunity to submit information and argument in opposition to the proposed debarment. To date, you have not responded.

Based upon the information in the administrative record in this matter, I have determined that protection of the Government's interests requires that you be debarred from Government procurement, nonprocurement and sales programs. The debarment is effective immediately and continues for three years from June 30, 2000, the date you were proposed for debarment from Government contracting. Your debarment will terminate on June 29, 2003.

The effects of debarment are those stated in the June 30, 2000, Notice of Proposed Debarment.
