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1. Fort Hood is petitioning the Public Utility Commission of Texas to become a wholesale electric commodity supplier. As a result Fort Hood must own their system.

Access and Utilization Protocol for the Bidders Library

A. OVERVIEW

The Bidder's Library consists of mapping of distribution systems (electricity, natural gas, water and wastewater). It also includes the Environmental Baseline Study (EBS) and the Utilities Privatization study. *In the library A Table of Contents is provided which list all supporting documents.*

B. LOCATION

The Bidder's Library is located on Fort Hood in Bldg 4612, Room #22. This room is located in the Northwest corner of the building.

C. HOURS OF OPERATION

The Bidder's Library will be open from 0800 – 1600, Monday through Thursday starting April 15, 2002 and ending September 26, 2002.

D. SCHEDULING VISITS

All who wish to access the Bidder's Library must schedule their visit with Fort Hood's Energy Office at least one day prior to intended visit. P.O.C.'s listed below. (Information regarding getting to and on base will be provided).

E. MATERIAL VIEWING TIME LIMIT

In order to allow equal opportunity for accessing the data contained in library, bidders are limited to a 4 hour per day maximum viewing session.

F. HANDLING OF LIBRARY MATERIALS

All library material (hardcopies) have been sorted and categorized as indicated in the Bidder's Library Table of Contents. All handled materials shall be returned to their originally intended file location and category. No original material (hardcopies) included, as a part of this Library shall be permitted to leave Room #22 of Bldg 4612. Most of the information contained in the Bidder's Library will be available on CD. A computer will be available onsite for viewing the information in this electronic format. This (3) CD set will be made available upon request.

G. ELECTRONIC COPIES

Bidders will be permitted to make electronic copies of Bidder's Library materials. For materials on the (3) CD set, Bidders may copy by bringing their own duplicating equipment [i.e. CD burner].
