
CONTRACTING INSTRUCTION (CI): 01-11
MEMORANDUM FOR CI Distribution

SUBJECT: DLAD Changes Clause for Commercial Item Acquisitions

In accordance with PROCLTR 01-04 dated March 19, 2001, this CI is to give notice of a new DLAD clause that is to be used in acquisitions negotiated under FAR Part 12 in conjunction with the tailorable I1.03-X series clauses (FAR 52.212-4, Contract Terms and Conditions - Commercial Items). The I1.03-X series clauses provide for bilateral agreement on contract terms and conditions during normal operations; the new (additional) clause allows the contracting officer to issue unilateral changes to the method of shipment, packing, and place of delivery during contingency operations, or humanitarian and peacekeeping missions, when time may not be available to negotiate such agreements in advance. The definition of humanitarian and peacekeeping operations, referenced in subparagraph (b)(2) of the new clause, is further defined in the Charter of the United Nations, Chapters VI and VII, attachments 2 and 3, respectively. This clause is issued under the authority of the DLA Senior Procurement Executive, Mr. William Kenny.

Therefore, effective immediately, in accordance with DLAD 12.302(b)(3)(91) (Attachment 1), new clause I1.08 (Attachment 1) shall be included, in addition to I1.03-X, in all commercial RFPs issued on or after March 19, 2001, or by amendment at the contracting officer's discretion. Current negotiated contracts may also be modified to include the new clause.

This CI is effective retroactive to March 19, 2001, and expires upon inclusion of the coverage in the DLAD. Point of contact is Cheri Bohman, extension 7626.
