CONTRACTING INSTRUCTION (CI): 99-15  
MEMORANDUM FOR CI Distribution

SUBJECT: Surge and Sustainment (S&S) Requirements

The purpose of this Contracting Instruction (CI) is to notify you of the recent change to the DLAD in accordance with PROCLTR 99-09, dated 23 July 1999, Subject Surge and Sustainment (S&S) Requirements. Paragraph 7.104(b)(91) of the DLAD has been changed to read in part:

...These measures are especially crucial when the new support method will eliminate or reduce DLA inventories. Acquisition plans for these new arrangements and LTCs must address S&S requirements, capability, and testing. If surge and/or sustainment requirements are not included in the solicitation (e.g., they do not exist, they are covered under other contractual arrangements, they are covered via sufficient peacetime assets, etc.), state this in the acquisition plan and explain the basis for not including them.

In light of the above DLAD change, Acquisition Plans (Section 29, of the DESC Form 15.10) shall now contain wording similar to the following:

No surge and/or sustainment requirements are included in this solicitation. See DESC's Annual Surge Plan on file in DESC-CP, which provides the basis for excluding surge provisions in DESC acquisitions and the alternative means of sustaining surge capability.

This Contracting Instruction is effective immediately and expires upon dissemination.
